

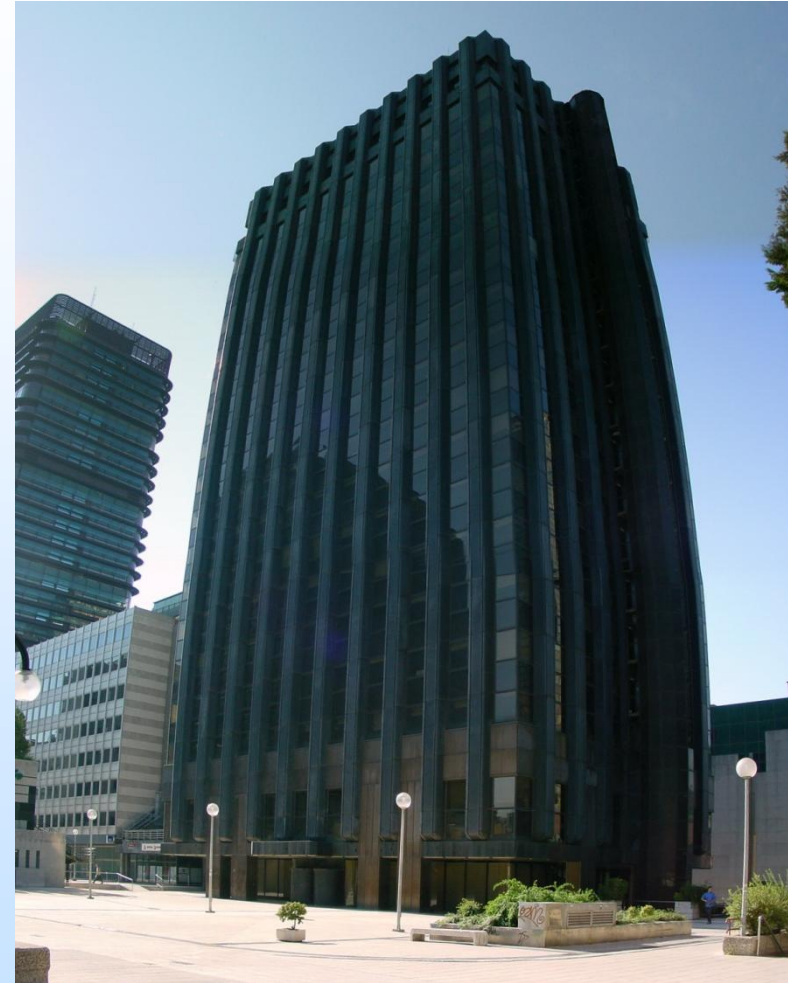

Canada – Spain PPH Pilot Project

Spanish Patent and Trademark Office

A PPH pilot project between CIPO and the Spanish Patent and Trademark Office (SPTO) will commence on October 1, 2010, for a period of two years ending on September 30, 2012. The trial period may be extended if necessary to adequately assess the feasibility of the PPH project.

The objective of the trial is to gauge the interest of applicants and to assess the anticipated benefits to each office. The SPTO and CIPO will evaluate the results of the pilot project to determine whether the project should be fully implemented after the trial period.

During the pilot, CIPO will process requests for advanced prosecution under the PPH project free of charge. CIPO will evaluate what, if any, fees should apply for this service if it later becomes permanent. Regular fees ([Schedule II of the Patent Rules](#)) for requesting examination will continue to apply during the PPH pilot.

The Offices may also terminate the PPH pilot project early if the volume of participation exceeds manageable level, or for any other reason. Notice will be published if the PPH pilot project terminates before the September 30, 2012, date.

Patent Prosecution Highway Between USPTO and SPTO (Pilot)

The Patent Prosecution Highway in Conjunction With the Spanish Patent and Trademark Office (SPTO)

Under the **Patent Prosecution Highway**, an applicant receiving a ruling from either the Spanish Patent and Trademark Office (SPTO) or the USPTO that at least one claim in an application is patentable may request that the other office fast-track the examination of corresponding claims in corresponding applications. The Patent Prosecution Highway will leverage fast-track patent examination procedures already available in both offices to allow applicants in both countries to obtain corresponding patents faster and more efficiently.

As of May 25, 2010, the USPTO has [eliminated the fee](#) for the petition to make special under the PPH programs.

The trial period starts on 01 October 2010 and is set to expire **30 September 2011**, but may be extended or terminated earlier depending on volume of activity and other factors. Both offices will provide notice of any adjustment in the pilot program.

15.Mar.2011 | Spain and Portugal together on the Patent Prosecution Highway



The Spanish and Portuguese IP Offices (OEPM and INPI) signed recently a Memorandum of Understanding concerning the establishment of a project on the Patent Prosecution Highway (PPH) programme, which will begin on June 1, 2011.

The project will initially last for two years, during which it will evaluate the results and the demand from applicants for patents. Subsequently, and upon the results achieved, the project can develop into a final stage.

PPH agreements enable patent offices to exchange information and speed up the processing of patent applications. Through this agreement, a Spanish or Portuguese patent applicant can request "accelerated processing" at the other office, due to the recognition of research activities already undertaken by the first PTO. Apart from the speed in obtaining the patent, the PPH also implies a significant reduction in costs to the protection process to avoid duplication of costs associated with research tasks.

The National Board of Patents and Registration of Finland (NBPR) has launched Patent Prosecution Highway (PPH) cooperative projects with the patent offices of Austria, Canada, Hungary, Japan, the Korean Republic, Russia, Spain and the United States of America. PPH agreements enable patent offices to exchange information and speeds up the processing of patent applications. Through these agreements, a Finnish patent applicant can request accelerated processing at the other office, if the claims in a corresponding application filed with that office have already been allowed by the NBPR.

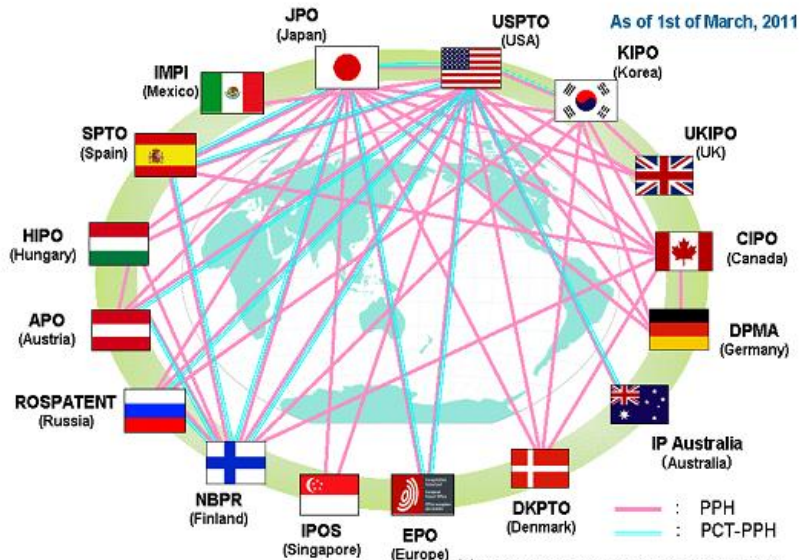
